NCGA Course Installs 4View Swing Recorder *4View Digital Swing Recorder is installed at Poppy Ridge Golf Course*

Union City, CA 12-2-05 – Inpractis Corporation announced the installation of its innovative 4View Digital Swing Recorder product at Poppy Ridge Golf Course in Livermore, CA, one of two member courses of the Northern California Golf Association (NCGA). The 4View system was installed in a site especially constructed for it at the Poppy Ridge driving range. Installation of a 4View system at Poppy Hills, the sister course to Poppy Ridge, was done in August 2005.

The 4View Digital Swing Recorder (DSR) is a powerful digital video capture device that golfers can use at the driving range to record, play back and analyze their swing. The innovative system captures the entire golf swing from two angles simultaneously and measures club head and ball flight speed; it provides a very powerful tool for the analysis and improvement of the swing.

Unlike many conventional swing recording systems, the 4View DSR is engineered to be a permanent fixture in the driving range bay and has been designed for complete self-service use by golfers. This highly interactive digital swing analysis tool features a patent pending user interface that is powerful yet extremely intuitive.

Both technically advanced and extremely rugged, 4View units are easily installed and require little to no maintenance from range operators.

Poppy Ridge, which first opened for play in October of 1996, is quite accessible to NCGA members, as 110,000 of the 200,000 members live within a 65-mile radius of the course.

Designed by Rees Jones, 1995 Golf Digest Architect of the Year, the 27-hole layout of Poppy Ridge is carved into the rugged terrain of the Livermore foot-hills. It offers spectacular views of the golf course and beyond. Each hole is shaped by extensive bunkering, giving the course a true links feel. The Merlot, Chardonnay and Zinfandel nines offer challenging and enjoyable golf for any level of player, with each nine measuring about 3,500 to 3,600 yards from the black tees.

The installation of the high tech 4View system underscores the commitment by the NCGA to the technology of the 4View system and the benefits it offers Poppy Ridge's golfers. The driving range at Poppy Ridge is predominantly grass. Because the 4View system is installed in a fixed location to maintain its camera positioning and ease of use, it requires a matted hitting area where golfers always hit from roughly the same point. So a dedicated area was built to accommodate the 4View. A concrete pad was constructed to create a matted tee area and support the permanently installed 4View system. The installation gives golfers using the 4View an exceptional space to enjoy the benefits of video feedback offered by 4View.
